**Unpaid debts will result in you not marching nor receiving your diploma.**

Seniors will be notified on Monday, **May 17<sup>th</sup>** with a printed list of books checked out and any remaining school debts. Any textbooks not currently being used may be turned in to the Bookstore at any time. All outstanding debts to the school must be paid to the Bookstore before **Friday, May 21st**. Payment of debts must be paid in cash or with a cashier's check; **personal checks will not be accepted**. (Debts include, but are not limited to, loans, lost locks, lost athletic equipment, damaged and/or lost textbooks, CD's, books or equipment loaned by teachers, etc.)

Book collection for seniors will be before or after school starting **Monday May 17 through Friday May 21 at the Bookstore window**. **Seniors are responsible for turning in their books to the Bookstore**. If a book has been lost, full payment of the book is necessary to clear the debt. Students should wait until the books are scanned and their textbook list is signed to be used as their receipt.
