SCHOOL COUNCIL MINUTES

February 15, 2012

Welcome Mr. Belden welcomed School Council members and thanked them for their continued support of Thunderbird High School.

Information Mr. Belden stated the purpose of the meeting was to review the requests submitted for undesignated tax credit monies and to decide the allocation of funds.

School Business A reallocation of club account money is called for when the accounts have remained dormant for more than two years. We currently have \$4,700 dollars in dormant club accounts. Mr. Belden called for a vote to either a.) Reallocate the dormant club money to the undesignated tax credit account or b.) Release the funds back to the clubs to be spent this school year.

Mr. Belden called for a vote on the use of funds in club accounts that no longer exist to purchase a class set of TI 83 calculators for Algebra 2. Due to the new math requirements stating that all students must take Algebra 2, the need for a more complex calculator has arisen. After this semester, these calculators would be available to be checked out at the bookstore. The cost of a class set of these calculators is approximately \$2,700. The amount of money remaining in the nonexistent club accounts is \$2,122.
