### Important Information

#### Dress Code for Graduates

**For women:** Skirts and blouses, dresses or pant suits. Strapless dresses are not encouraged.

No denim/jeans.

**For men:** Dress shirts, preferably with a tie, and dress slacks.

No denim/jeans.

**For both men & women:** Dress shoes must be worn, no flip flops or tennis shoes.

Leave clothes hangers, purses, food, gum, beverages, sunglasses, cell phones, camera and other items in the car.

The only item you can bring into the ceremony is your **CAR KEYS**.

#### Dress Code for Guests

Guests must be appropriately dressed for admission to the graduation ceremony. Those who come wearing cut-offs, tank tops or flip-flops, for example, will be turned away.

Please do not bring flowers, balloons, or other gifts into the graduation ceremony. These items will not be allowed into the building, and guests will be asked to take them to their car.

### Expectations

**To preserve the dignity of the ceremony:**

- ▶ Guests should treat graduation as a formal ceremony.
- ▶ Spectators are asked to act with restraint and not applaud, whistle, or yell out to graduates during the calling of graduates' names.
- ▶ Air horns are not permitted and will be confiscated.
- ▶ Any student found to have been drinking or to be under the influence of any drug or to possess alcohol or drugs of any kind will not be permitted to participate.
