## ATHLETIC CLEARANCE INFORMATION FOR TEAM SPORTS

Athletic clearance packets are available in the administrative office.

Please follow the checklist provided on the front of the packet to ensure that all steps have been completed.

Complete packets must be turned into the athletic office in person to ensure that all documents meet all requirements. Please check that you have attached all needed forms and that all signatures are complete before submitting. **Do not fax or email forms.**

### ***(INCOMPLETE PACKETS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED)***

All student athletes must complete a new packet every year. (Brainbook Test is the only exception.)

Students need only to be cleared once per school year. However, students must come into the athletic office to verify that they have been cleared by their coach to play another sport. All student athletes must have current health insurance. School insurance is available for purchase, forms are available in the administrative office.

**It is highly recommended to get cleared for any and all sports at the beginning of the school year.**

## OUT OF SEASON LIABILITY RELEASE FORM AND CONSENT FOR EMERGENCY CARE

Out of Season Liability Forms are available in the administration building or by the coach.

This form is required prior to participation in any preseason sporting activity (Example: weight lifting, open gym, clinics, etc.) The form must be completed and given to the coach.

***Students may not participate in any activities before turning in the Release form.***

## TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation is available for the Thunderbird attendance area if you live more than 1.5 miles from school.

## GENERAL REGISTRATION INFO

Pre-registered students begin in Practice Gym.  
New students will begin in building A in the Thunderdome.

Pre-registered students do not need to bring birth certificate or custody paperwork unless a letter was sent home requesting these documents, or if you want to play Sports. **Copy of birth certificate & custody documents required for sports.**

**ALL RETURNING STUDENTS REGISTERING** must update their Health History Record by filling out the enclosed form. Updated Health Form can be mailed or turned in to the nurse in the Media Center.

## FRESHMEN REGISTRATION

**Begin in the Media Center**

Emergency/Health Information Card or any other information required by the nurse are to be filled out at nurse's station. **Parent/Guardian signature is required.**

## **ATTENTION: PLEASE BE AWARE**

During the freshman registration process, incoming freshmen that did not complete testing in May should plan to spend approximately 30 to 45 minutes taking the Scholastic Reading Inventory, or SRI and the Math Placement Test.

These tests are a computer-based assessment that provide schools with a picture of students proficiency and helps schools make accurate English & math placement recommendation. Parents who have questions about the assessment process during registration, are encouraged to contact the school.

Parents please plan accordingly for enough time.

## RECORDS OFFICE

**ALL New Freshmen and New Students registering must provide the following items:**

- Copy of birth certificate & copy parent/guardian photo ID
- Copy of custody paperwork if applicable
- Verifiable documentation of immunizations- DPT, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella - as required by state law
- Proof of residence (ie- utility bill, lease agreement)
- Emergency/Health Information Card, including current contact information
- Parent/Guardian photo ID & signature required

**Federal Law requires a birth certificate and custody paperwork showing guardianship.**

Please email, mail, fax or stop in with copy for the records office ASAP.
